Like many families in this postwar generation, the parents had grown up during the Great Depression. When World War II began, lots of young women like Tom's mother left their jobs as housewives and full-time mothers and never went back. Family life after the war was never the same again. Those changes began with kids like Tom. The freedom and thrill-seeking he experiences growing up in the 1950s will ring true to others who grew up in this era.
